## Conditions of Play

1. Each game will be played over 2 sets comprising of 9 end sets for singles, 7 end sets for pairs and 7 end sets for triples. A One end Tie Break will be played if set score is tied.
2. The winner of a set is the one with the highest score.
3. If shot scores are tied after the end of a set it will be counted as a drawn set.
4. If a game is tied after 2 sets ( 1 set each) a tie break of one end is to be played. Skips will toss before starting the tie break.
5. Winner of the tie break is the winner of the game. Tie Break Score is not counted.
6. First set: The winner of the toss can choose the who can go first.
7. The winner of the first set leads off the second set.
8. If a draw the winner of the last end of the first set leads off.
9. If an end is killed, the jack is placed on the 2-metre mark.
10. Power Play - each team is entitled to 1 power play per set. They must inform the marker and opposition in Singles, and Inform the opposing skip in pairs and triples before the end commences.
When a powerplay is declared a different colour jack is placed. This makes it clear for the leads and spectators to know when powerplays occur.
11. If the team wins the power play end, the shots scored in that end are doubled.
12. Both teams can use their PP in the same end. It cannot be used in a tie break.
13. Scoring: 3 game points will be awarded for each game won.

14 . 1 set point will be awarded for each set won. A half (0.5) point will be awarded for each drawn set. Differential will apply NOT counting a tie break.
15. Winning team with the highest number of game points. Total number of set points, differential.
16. One coach/team manager is to report to the umpire before play begins. This person may give advice to their team (player) only when they have possession of the rink and does so from outside the boundaries of the green.
17. Spectators: Must stay outside the boundaries of the green and clear of the players. They must not disturb or advise the players in any way.
18. Any disputes must be brought to the Tournament Manager whose decision is final.

## Conditions of Play

## Eligibility of players.

Players who are 18 or under who attend a school e.g., college, intermediate or a primary school, are eligible. Players who attend a university or polytechnic are not eligible. Players who are 18 years old and don't attend a college, university or polytechnic are also not eligible to play.

Centres can bring in players from other centres to fill their team
This allows for centres who can't field a team to invite players from other centres to make up their team
