UNDER 26 NATIONAL 5-A-SIDE CONDITIONS

SINGLES

- 21 UP. OR 2 HOURS' TIME LIMIT.
- NO DEAD ENDS, JACK WILL BE RE-SPOTTED AS PER LAW 56.5.3 (ONE RE-SPOT POSITION) IN THE LAWS OF THE SPORT OF BOWLS.
- A PLAYER MAY NOT GO TO THE HEAD UNTIL AFTER THEIR THIRD BOWL HAS BEEN DELIVERED.

PAIRS

- 3 X 3 BOWL PAIRS.
- 18 ENDS OR 2 HOURS' TIME LIMIT.
- NO DEAD ENDS, JACK WILL BE RE-SPOTTED AS PER LAW 56.5.3 (ONE RE-SPOT POSITION) IN THE LAWS OF THE SPORT OF BOWLS.
- LEADS CANNOT GO TO THE HEAD UNTIL THEY HAVE DELIVERED THEIR THIRD BOWL.
- SKIPS MAY ONLY VISIT THE HEAD AFTER THEY HAVE DELIVERED THEIR SECOND BOWL.

TRIPLES

- 2 X 2 X 2 BOWL TRIPLES.
- 18 ENDS OR 2 HOURS' TIME LIMIT.
- NO DEAD ENDS, JACK WILL BE RE-SPOTTED AS PER LAW 56.5.3 (ONE RE-SPOT POSITION) IN THE LAWS OF THE SPORT OF BOWLS.
- LEADS AND SECONDS CANNOT GO TO THE HEAD UNTIL THEY HAVE DELIVERED THEIR SECOND BOWL.

FOURS

- 2 X 2 X 2 X 2 BOWL FOURS.
- 15 ENDS OR 2 HOURS' TIME LIMIT.
- NO DEAD ENDS, JACK WILL BE RE-SPOTTED AS PER LAW 56.5.3 (ONE RE-SPOT POSITION) IN THE LAWS OF THE SPORT OF BOWLS.
- LEADS, SECONDS & THIRDS CANNOT GO TO THE HEAD UNTIL THEY HAVE DELIVERED THEIR SECOND BOWL.





GENERAL

- A TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE AND CONTROLLING BODY SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY BOWLS WELLINGTON TO CONDUCT THE EVENT.
- EACH CENTRE WILL HAVE FIVE PLAYERS WHO WILL PLAY IN EITHER SINGLES OR FOURS AND PAIRS OR TRIPLES.
- EACH PLAYER MUST BE UNDER THE AGE OF 26 AS AT THE START DATE OF LAST SEASON. A MANAGER IS EXPECTED TO ACCOMPANY THE TEAM AND BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PLAYERS.
- THIS IS AN OPEN GENDER EVENT. TEAM MAKE-UP CAN BE OF ANY GENDER FOR THE EVENT.
- PLAYERS CANNOT SWAP FROM ONE DISCIPLINE TO ANOTHER THROUGHOUT THE WHOLE EVENT; PLAYERS MAY SWAP POSITIONS IN A RINK PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF EACH GAME.
- A RESERVE MAY TAKE THE PLACE OF A TEAM MEMBER UPON AGREEMENT WITH THE CONTROLLING BODY. THE REPLACED PLAYER MAY ONLY GO BACK INTO HIS/HER ORIGINAL TEAM.
- EACH INDIVIDUAL RINK WILL TOSS BEFORE THE START OF EACH GAME TO DECIDE WHO WILL HAVE THE MAT.
- TWO TRIAL ENDS WILL BE PERMITTED BEFORE THE START OF THE FIRST GAME OF EACH DAY ONLY.
- 3 POINTS WILL BE AWARDED FOR A RINK (DISCIPLINE) WIN AND 1 POINT FOR A RINK DRAW, 0 POINTS FOR A RINK LOSS.
- THE TOP 2 PLACING'S WILL PLAY A FULL FINAL ROUND AND WILL BE DECIDED ON TOTAL CENTRE WIN POINTS, THEN MARGIN, THEN PROPORTIONAL VALUE AFTER 7 ROUNDS (14 MATCHES).
- FINALS WILL SEE 1ST V 2ND, 3RD V 4TH, 5TH V 6TH, IN EACH DISCIPLINE (TWO ROUNDS); FINALS GAMES WILL BE DECIDED ON TOTAL CLUB WIN POINTS, THEN MARGIN; IF STILL A TIE: EACH PLAYER FROM EITHER SIDE WILL PLAY A ONE END SINGLES SHOOT OUT, SHOTS WILL NOT BE COUNTED, THE WINNING SIDE WILL WIN AT LEAST THREE OF THE FIVE RINKS, EACH SINGLES GAME WILL TOSS FOR THE MAT TO START THE SHOOTOUT END, A DRAW WILL BE DONE BY THE CONTROLLING BODY FOR THE FIVE RINKS AND PLAYERS. THE 7TH PLACED SIDE WILL PLAY AN INVITATION TEAM ON THE FINAL DAY.
- THE CONTROLLING BODY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ALTER CONDITIONS IF NECESSARY.
- ANY POINT NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THE RULES AND CONDITIONS OF PLAY WILL BE DECIDED BY THE CONTROLLING BODY.
- ALL PLAYERS FROM EACH CENTRE MUST BE ATTIRED THE SAME IN EITHER CENTRE OR SPONSORED ATTIRE.
- ALL OTHER LAWS OTHER THAN STATED ABOVE SHALL CONFORM TO THE LAWS OF THE SPORT OF BOWLS.
- IN THE CASE OF A DISPUTE ARISING, THIS WILL BE REFERRED TO THE DISPUTE COMMITTEE WHOSE DECISION WILL BE FINAL.


