Dear clubs,

With Wellington moving to Level 2 from Wednesday, September 8th, please find the following guidelines for Wellington clubs to re-open safely and successfully.

Venue

- Clubs must display QR Codes and Covid signage. Sanitiser must be provided.
- Clubs must provide manual tracing opportunities for everyone on site, including name, date, time and contact details.
- Chairs and tables are to be set 2m apart to ensure social distancing. Bar leaners and other congregation points to be removed or blocked off.
- A maximum of 50 people are permitted in the clubrooms.
- Masks are strongly encouraged to be worn within clubrooms.
- All seats, door handles, toilets, and other surface areas must be sanitized regularly.

Games/Members

- 1m social distancing within a team and 2m social distancing between teams should be observed.
- No shaking hands before or after a game.
- The same person from each team is to roll jack and place the mat each time.
- Mats and jacks must be sanitised after use.
- Masks are strongly encouraged while on the green.
- All members must sign in at clubs, either electronically or manually.
- Fours are permitted, widening of rinks is not required (this is a Bowls NZ change in stance from their recommendations last year). However, safety, hygiene and number of people needs to be considered.
