## Conditions of Play \& Format:

Singles:

Triples: 18 completed ends ( 2 bowls)
21 shots
18 completed ends
15 completed ends

## 2-hour time limit on all rounds

## Singles

- 21 up, or 2 hours' time limit.
- Killed ends allowed, no re-spots
- A player may not go to the head until they have delivered their third bowl.


## Pairs

- 3 bowl pairs.
- 18 ends or 2 hours' time limit.
- Killed ends allowed, no re-spots
- Leads cannot go to the head until they have delivered their third bowl.
- Skips may only visit the head after they have delivered their second bowl.


## Triples

- 2 bowl triples.
- 18 ends or 2 hours' time limit.
- Killed ends allowed, no re-spots
- Leads and seconds cannot go to the head until they have delivered their second bowl.


## Fours

- 2 bowl fours.
-15 ends or 2 hours' time limit.
- Killed ends allowed, no re-spots
- Leads, seconds \& thirds cannot go to the head until they have delivered their second bowl.


## General

The Tournament Committee and Controlling Body shall be established by Bowls Wellington to conduct this event.

They will have the right to alter or amend playing conditions should circumstances necessitate such changes.

Each Centre will select 1 Singles Player, 1 Pair, 1 Triple, and 1 Four. Players can change within a discipline and only change between disciplines for health concerns.

Each individual rink will toss before the start of each game to decide who will have the mat.

Two trial ends will be permitted before the start of the first game.
All players from each Centre must be attired the same, in their Centre uniform.

Smoking is not permitted on/near the Green during an event.
Other restrictions are as per the host club's requirements Players and spectators cell phones should be set on 'silent' while any play is in progress. If it is necessary to respond to a call, players are requested to leave the green.

Any point not provided for in the rules and conditions of play will be decided by the Controlling Body.

All other laws other than stated above shall conform to the Laws of the Sport of Bowls, Crystal Mark Fourth Edition.

## Score cards:

Cards to be signed by both skips at the completion of game.

## Results:

Match Points: - Win $=2 \mathrm{pt}$, Draw $=1 \mathrm{pt}$, Loss $=0 \mathrm{pt}$.
Winners determined by most points or, if even, then by differential over all rounds, and then by most 'shots for' over all rounds.
