## SINGLES

- 21 UP, OR 2 HOURS' 30 MINUTES TIME LIMIT.
- KILLED ENDS ALLOWED, NO RE-SPOTS
- **A PLAYER MAY NOT GO TO THE HEAD UNTIL AFTER THEIR THIRD BOWL HAS BEEN DELIVERED.**

## PAIRS

- 3 X 3 BOWL PAIRS.
- 18 ENDS OR 2 HOURS' 30 MINUTES TIME LIMIT.
- KILLED ENDS ALLOWED, NO RE-SPOTS
- **LEADS CANNOT GO TO THE HEAD UNTIL THEY HAVE DELIVERED THEIR THIRD BOWL.**
- **SKIPS MAY ONLY VISIT THE HEAD AFTER THEY HAVE DELIVERED THEIR SECOND BOWL.**

## TRIPLES

- 2 X 2 X 2 BOWL TRIPLES.
- 18 ENDS OR 2 HOURS' 30 MINUTES TIME LIMIT.
- KILLED ENDS ALLOWED, NO RE-SPOTS
- **LEADS AND SECONDS CANNOT GO TO THE HEAD UNTIL THEY HAVE DELIVERED THEIR SECOND BOWL.**

## FOURS

- 2 X 2 X 2 X 2 BOWL FOURS.
- 15 ENDS OR 2 HOURS' 30 MINUTES TIME LIMIT.
- KILLED ENDS ALLOWED, NO RE-SPOTS
- **LEADS, SECONDS & THIRDS CANNOT GO TO THE HEAD UNTIL THEY HAVE DELIVERED THEIR SECOND BOWL.**





# GENERAL

- **A TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE AND CONTROLLING BODY SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY BOWLS WELLINGTON TO CONDUCT THIS EVENT. THEY WILL HAVE THE RIGHT TO ALTER OR AMEND PLAYING CONDITIONS SHOULD CIRCUMSTANCES NECESSITATE SUCH CHANGES**
  - **EACH INDIVIDUAL RINK WILL TOSS BEFORE THE START OF EACH GAME TO DECIDE WHO WILL HAVE THE MAT.**
  - **TWO TRIAL ENDS WILL BE PERMITTED BEFORE THE START OF THE FIRST GAME.**
  - **2 POINTS WILL BE AWARDED FOR A RINK (DISCIPLINE) WIN AND 1 POINT FOR A RINK DRAW, 0 POINTS FOR A RINK LOSS.**
  - **RESULTS WILL BE GENDER SPECIFIC. THE LADIES WILL PLAY FOR THEIR TROPHY, THE MEN WILL PLAY FOR THEIR TROPHY. NO COMBINED SCORES.**
  - **TOTAL MATCH POINTS WILL DECIDE THE EVENT, IF TIED MOST WINS WILL DECIDE THE EVENT, IF STILL TIED HIGHEST DIFFERENTIAL WILL DECIDE THE EVENT.**
- EACH CENTRE WILL SELECT 1 SINGLES PLAYER, 1 PAIR, 1 TRIPLE, AND 1 FOUR.**
- **SCORECARDS TO BE FILLED IN INCLUDING THE NAMES OF ALL PLAYERS.**
  - **CARDS TO BE SIGNED BY BOTH SKIPS AT THE COMPLETION OF GAME.**
  - **SHOULD GAMES BE TIED AT COMPLETION OF THE GAME OR TIME EXPIRES THESE RESULTS WILL BE RECORDED AS DRAWS AND ONE POINT ALLOCATED PER TEAM**
  - **ANY POINT NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THE RULES AND CONDITIONS OF PLAY WILL BE DECIDED BY THE CONTROLLING BODY.**
  - **ALL PLAYERS FROM EACH CENTRE MUST BE ATTIRED THE SAME, IN THEIR CENTRE UNIFORM.**
  - **ALL OTHER LAWS OTHER THAN STATED ABOVE SHALL CONFORM TO THE LAWS OF THE SPORT OF BOWLS.**
  - **IN THE CASE OF A DISPUTE ARISING, THIS WILL BE REFERRED TO THE DISPUTE COMMITTEE WHOSE DECISION WILL BE FINAL.**
